Enhanced Pass Plus Scheme

What is the Enhanced Pass Plus Scheme?

North Yorkshire County Council's Enhanced Pass Plus Scheme offers newly qualified drivers the opportunity to reduce their insurance premiums whilst further developing their driving. The scheme is based on the Driving Standards Agency (DSA) Pass Plus Scheme but is specifically targeted at the dangers new drivers face when on North Yorkshire's road network.



How much does it cost?

Participating instructors have agreed to only charge £174 to deliver the scheme and North Yorkshire County Council will pay £75 of this fee.

So all you pay is £99.

Does every one qualify for the subsidy?

To qualify for the subsidy:

- you must be resident in the North Yorkshire area;
- have passed your driving test in the last 9 months:
- agree to attend a 2 hour New Driver
 Discussion Group held within the North
 Yorkshire area; and
- be willing to help us evaluate the scheme.

There are only limited places so there is no guarantee.

How is the subsidy paid?

Your subsidised course will normally be delivered as 3x2 hour sessions. You pay your instructor for:

Session 1 = £55

Session 2 = £32

Session 3 = £12

At the end of your course we will pay your instructor the remaining £75 of the £174 course fees.

What are the insurance discounts?

The instructor will issue you with a DSA Pass Plus certificate which may entitle you to an insurance discount with some insurers. You will need to check with your insurer to see what discount they will offer. Not all insurers participate in the scheme.

Is there another test?

No, your driving will be assessed by the instructor over the period of the course. If you need to take extra lessons to reach the Pass Plus standard then you would need to book these through your instructor at your own expense.

What happens at the New Driver Discussion Group

This is a highly interactive discussion that aims to help you understand how various factors can impact on your driving. The discussion groups are held across North Yorkshire. We will write to you with a date and time of a group once you have registered with us through your instructor.



Please note if you do not attend a New Driver Discussion Group within 8 weeks of joining the scheme we will withdraw the offer of the subsidy and may seek to reclaim any subsidy we have already paid on your behalf directly from you.
