Or design and make a leaflet about cycling with top tips for being a safer cyclist.

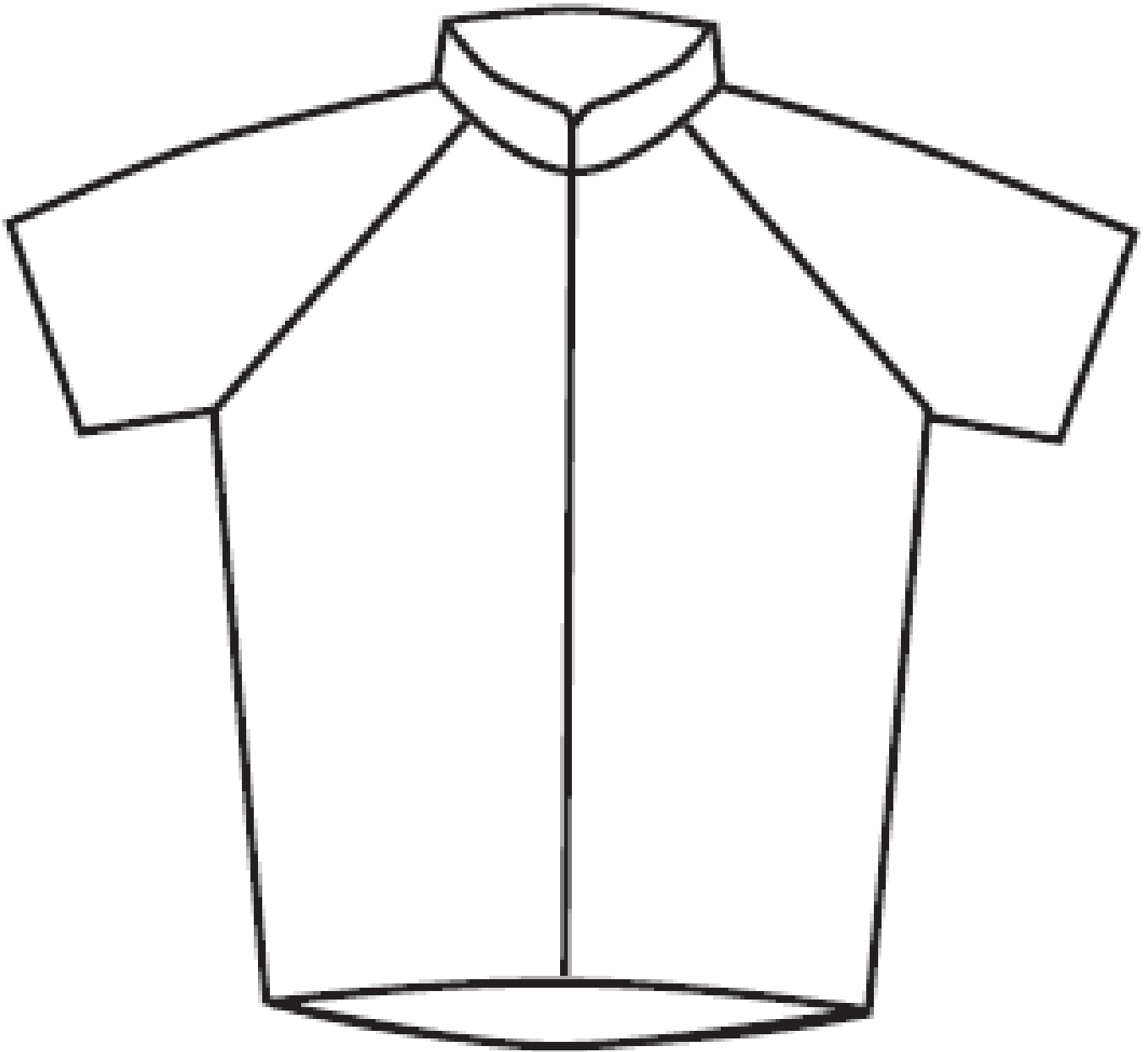
