Prompt sheet: Campaign Ideas

Flipchart / Board to record information

ACTIVITIES:

> Remind the class of the previous work and the main findings of the survey.

- > Explain that the class need to decide on a realistic number of recommendations based on the survey results.
- > These recommendations will be presented to a wider audience eg parents, Parish Council, Road Safety Officer, School Travel Plans Officer
- > The Chairperson should keep the class on task and make sure that everyone can contribute ideas. The minute taker should note the main points.
- > The class should agree on a small number of recommendations, voting if necessary
- Once the main recommendations are agreed the class should decide how best to share their work with the rest of the school. Use the prompt Sheet: Campaign Ideas. Decide on which of the ideas would be most appropriate.

PLENARY Reflect on how the children feel the campaign will be received by others.
